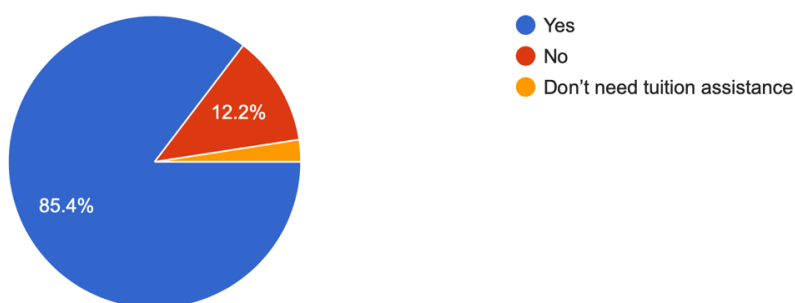

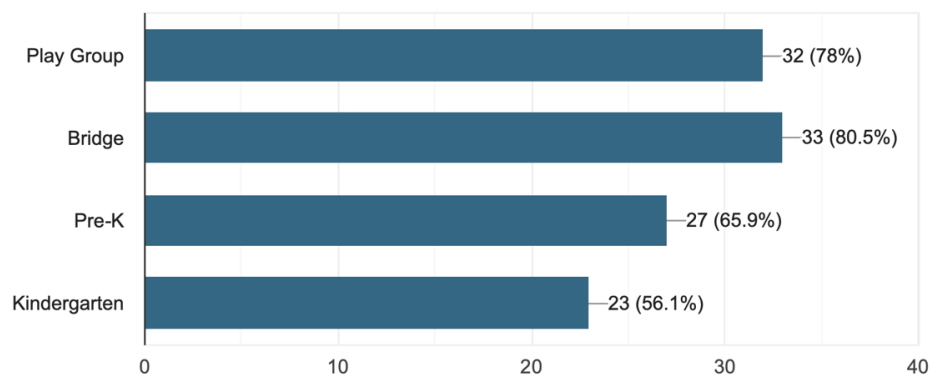

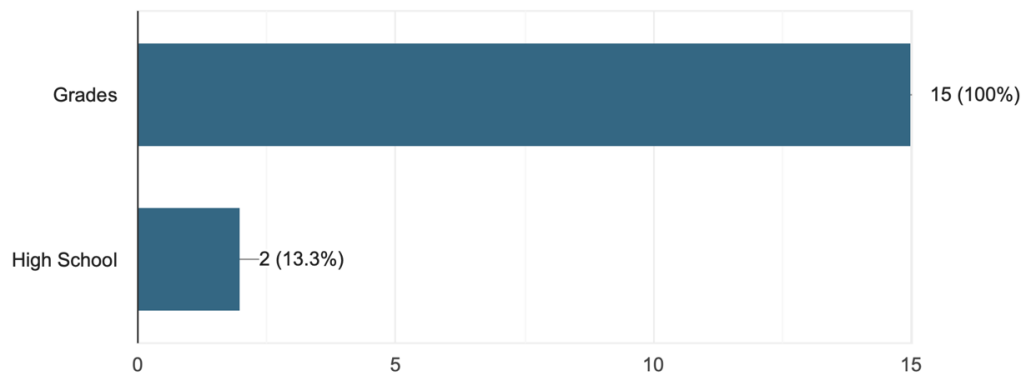
During your time at WSOC, how many EC programs has your child/children participated in? Check all that apply.

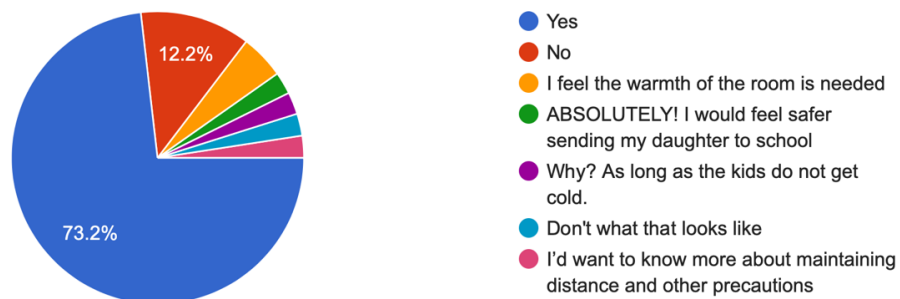

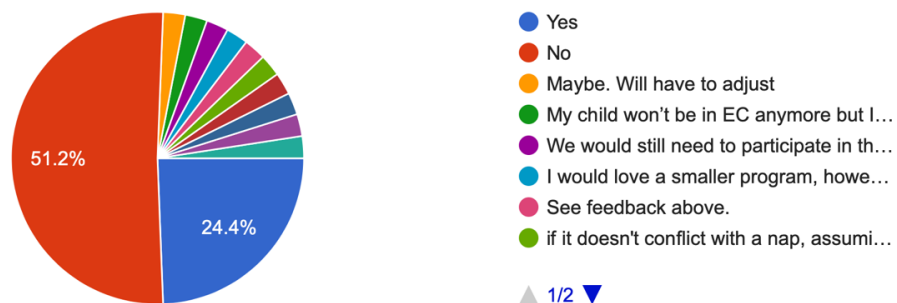

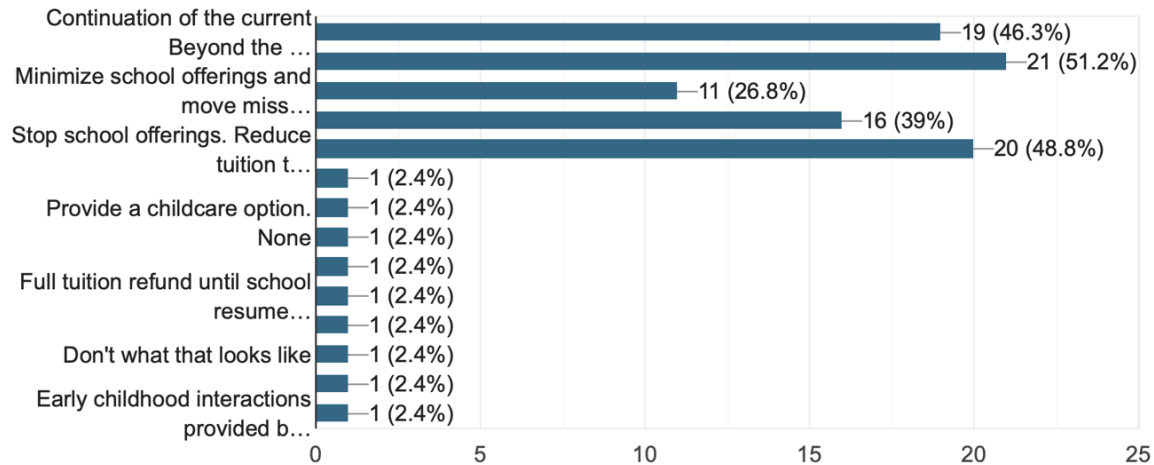

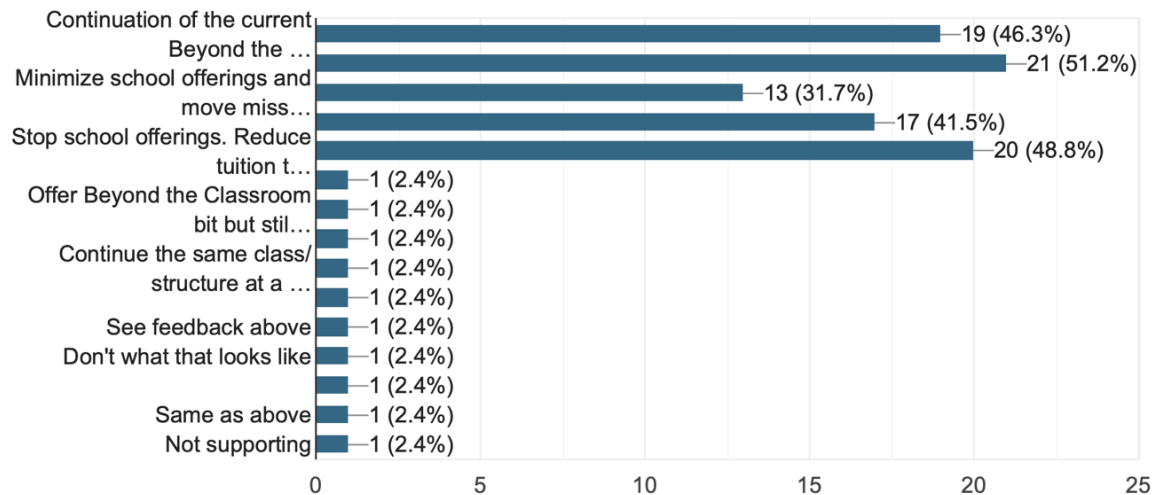

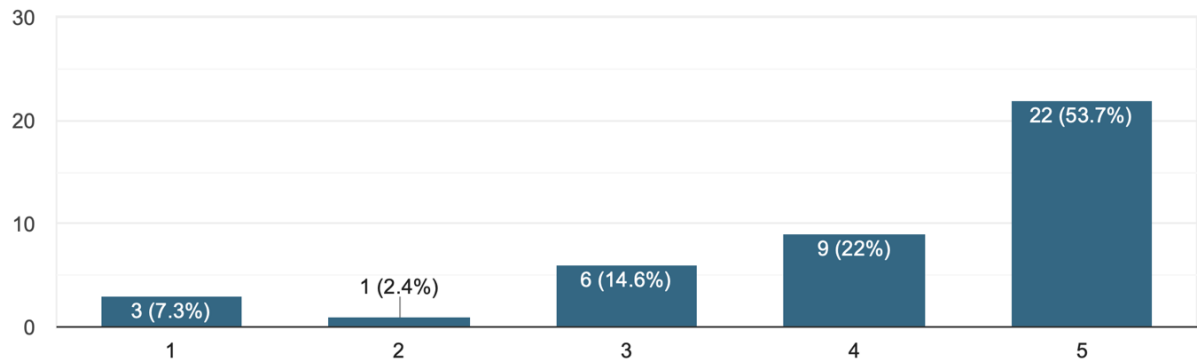

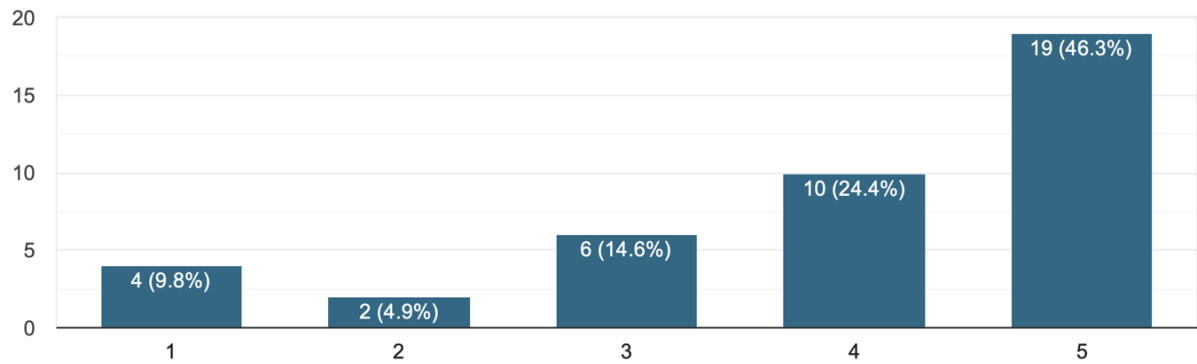
How important is it to you that your child to keep a connection with their own class teacher specifically during an extended closure?

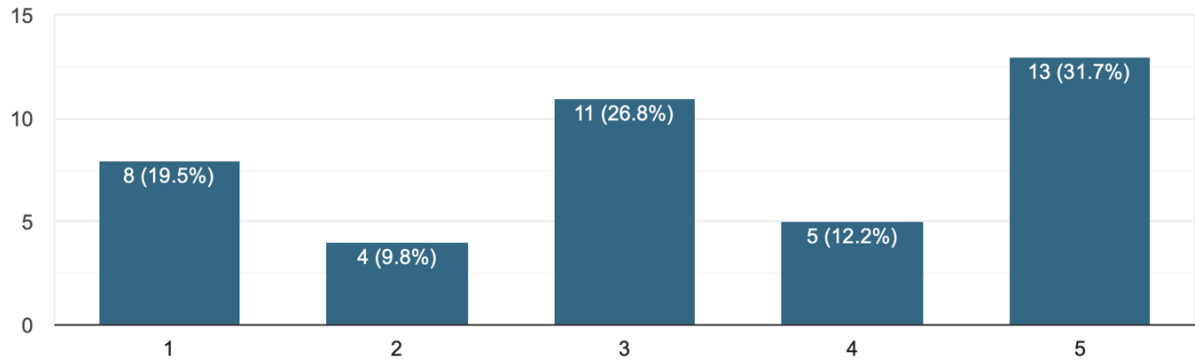
How important is it to you to keep, for yourself, a connection with your child's specific class teacher during an extended closure?

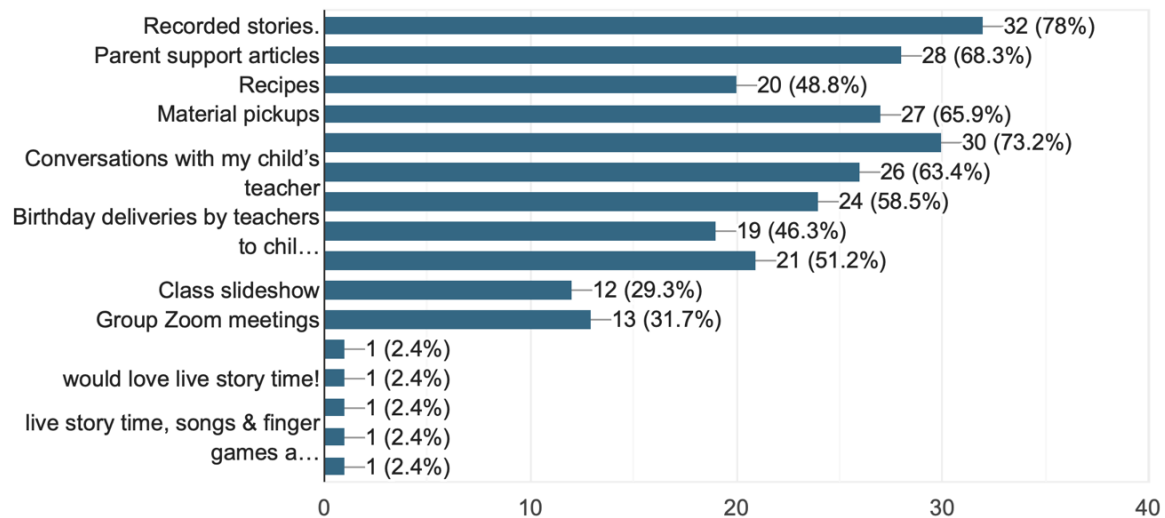
How do you feel about your child interacting with screens as a part of their school experience during an extended closure?

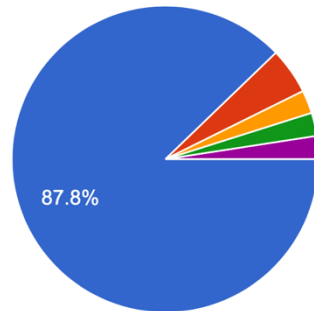

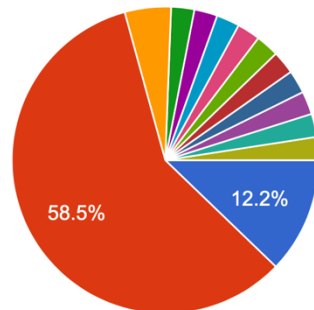

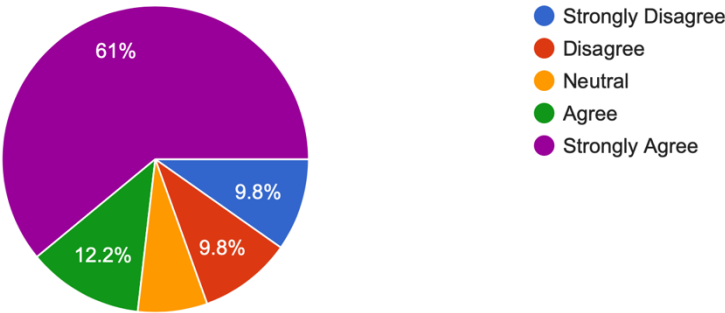
In the case of California not allowing schools to open on campus by September 8, which scenarios would you find acceptable, if not preferable? (Check all that you feel equally good about.)

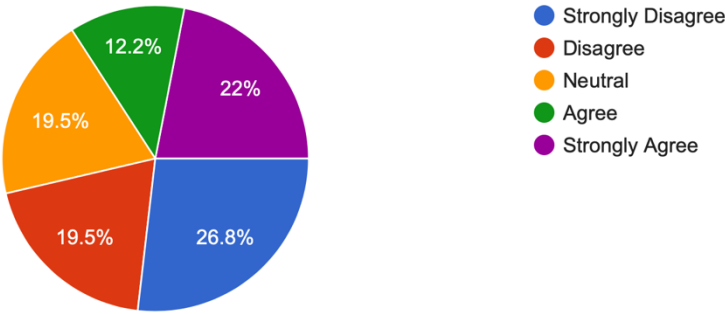

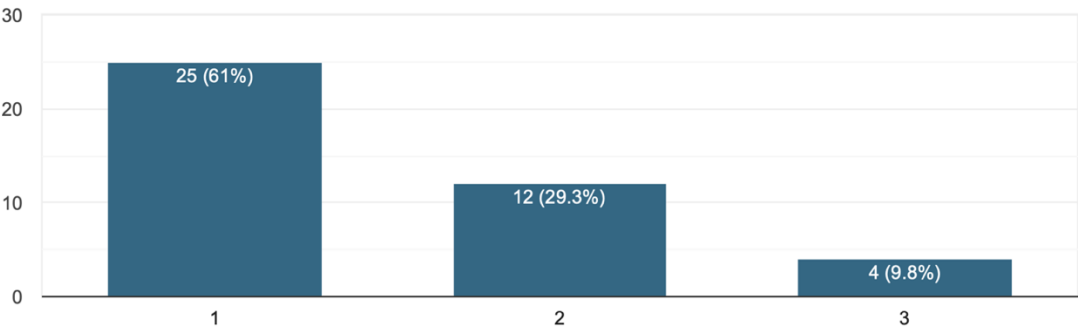

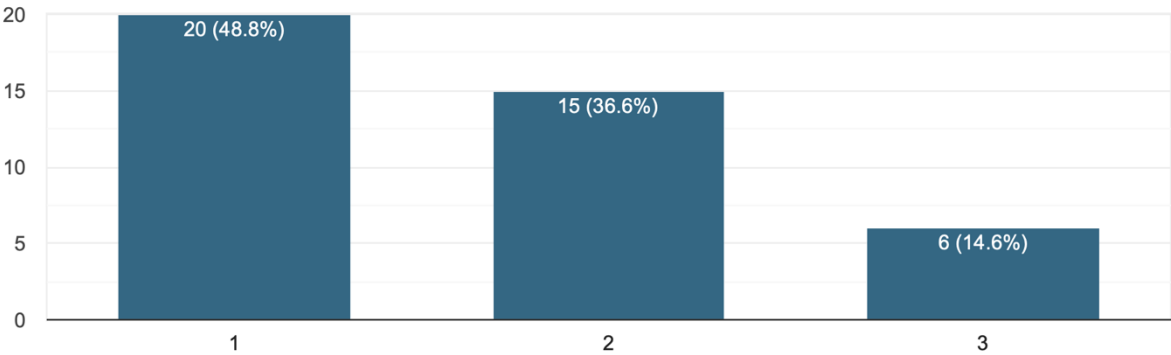
How important to your family is an 8:00 am early drop-off option?

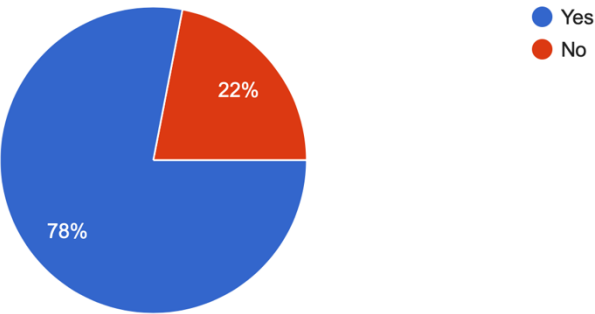

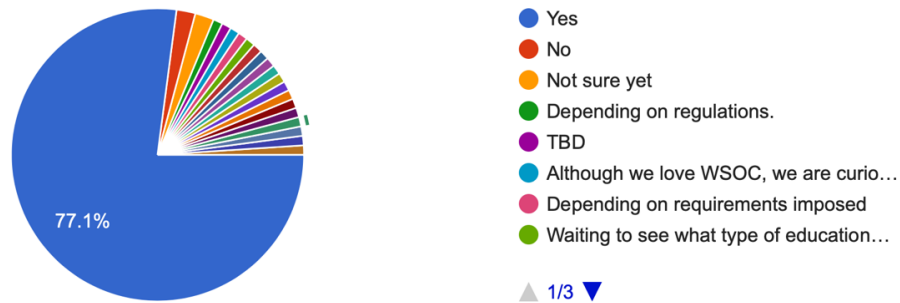

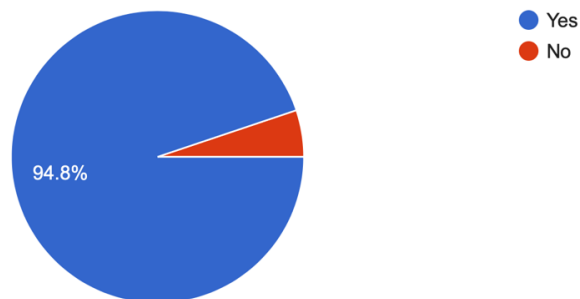

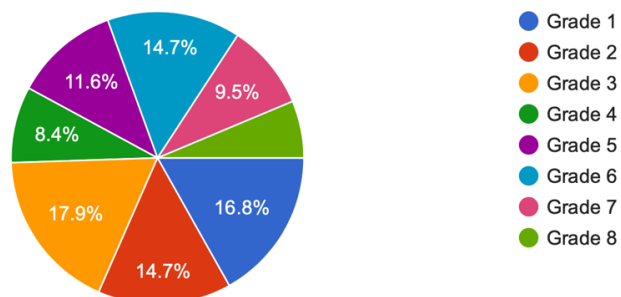

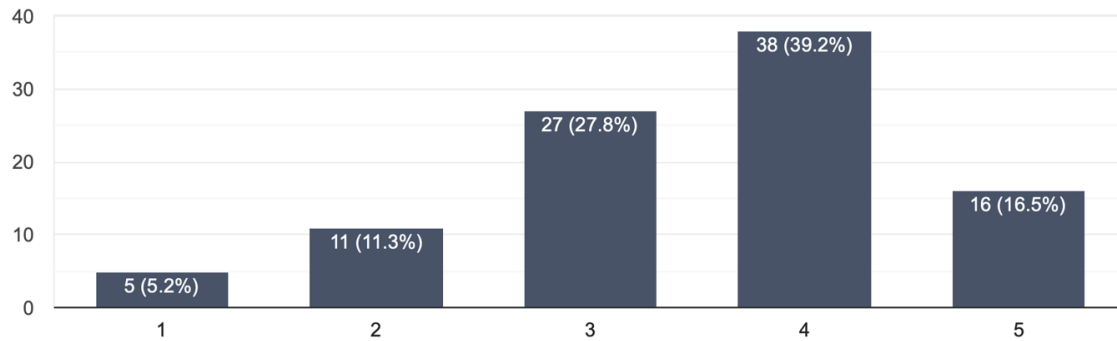

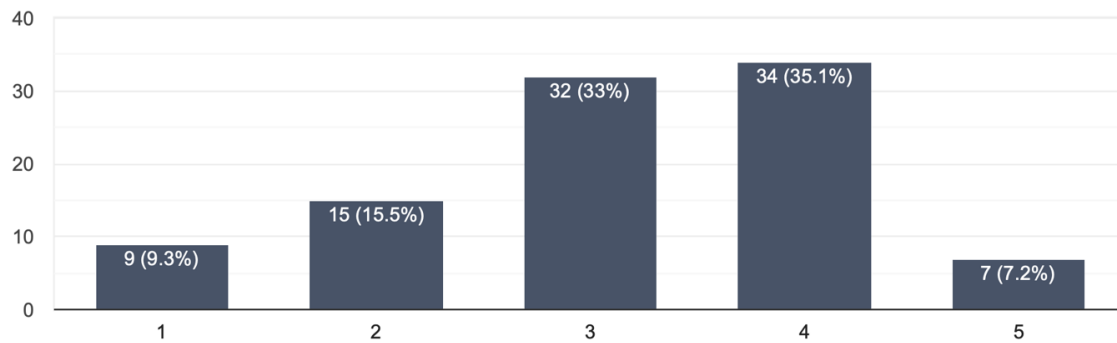

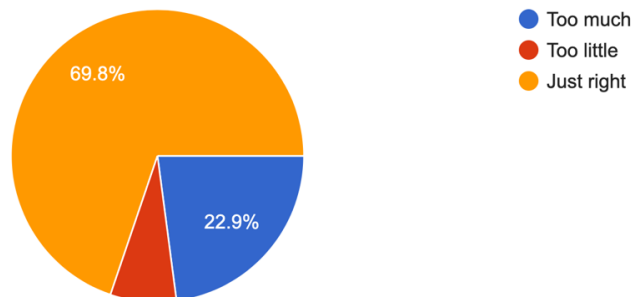

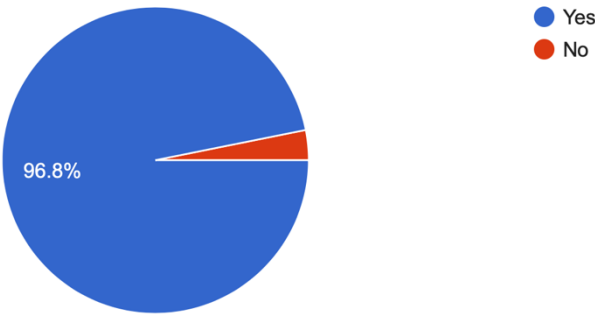
How many hours on average does your child spend daily completing schoolwork?

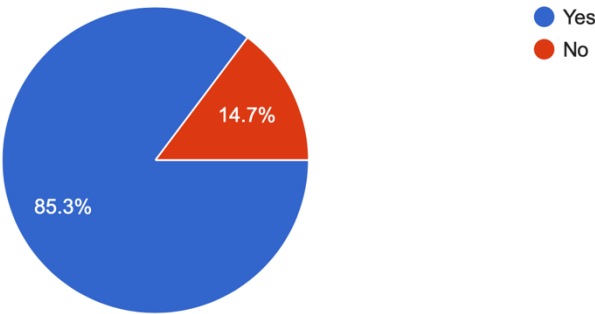
Do you feel you have enough access to your child's Main Lesson teacher ?

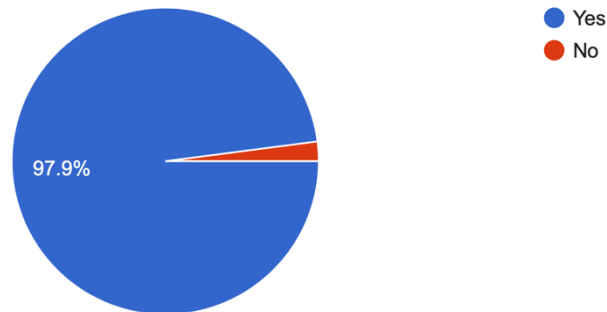

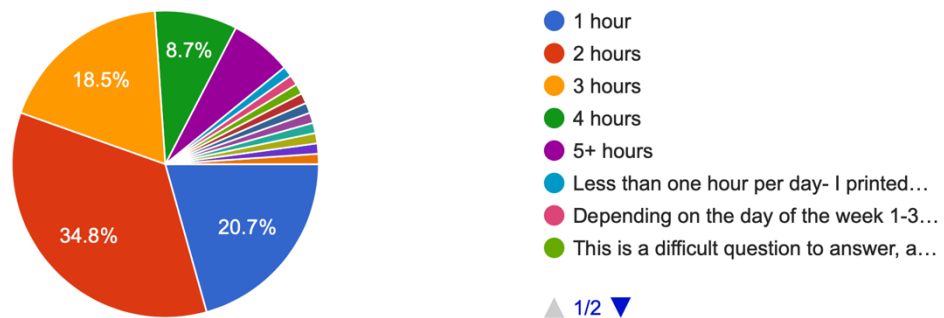

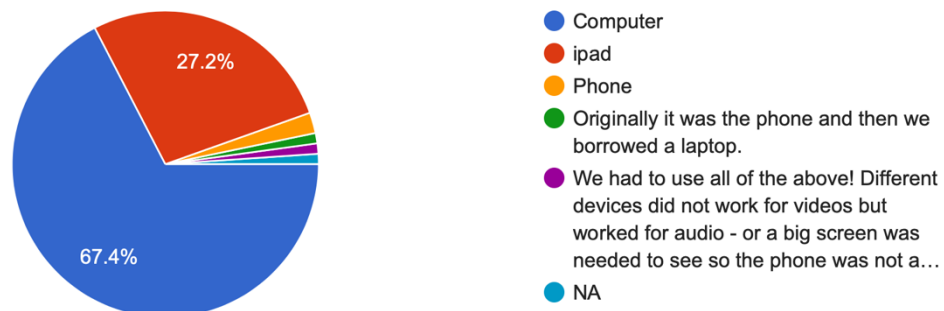
How much of their school day was spent on screen?

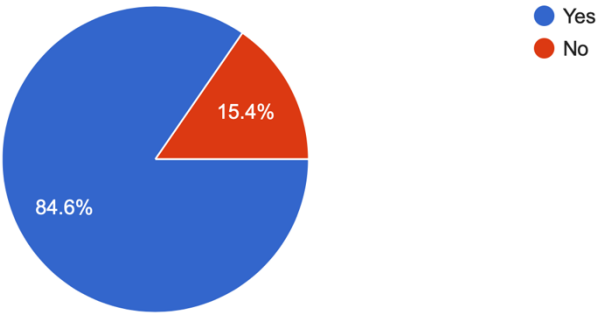
What is your child's primary source of technology to access Google Classroom?

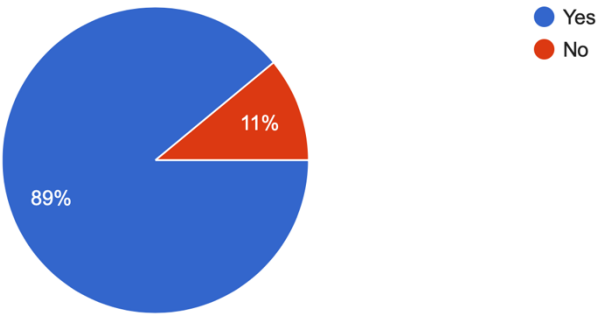
Do they have access to this equipment throughout the school day from 8:30 am- 2:50 pm?

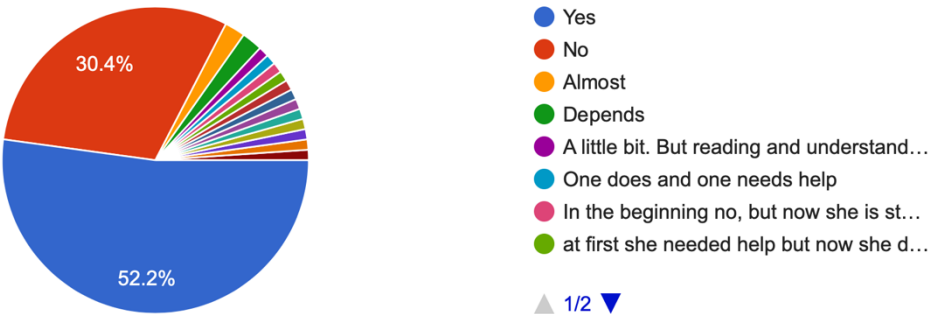

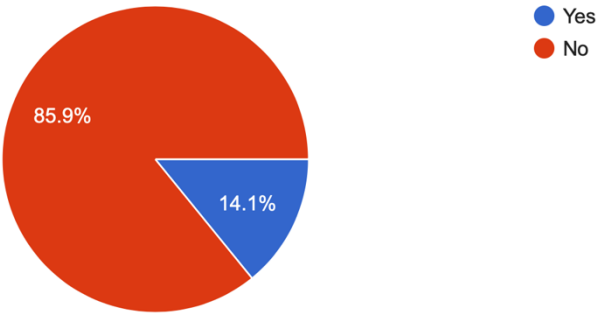


Is your child able to independently navigate their Google Classroom?

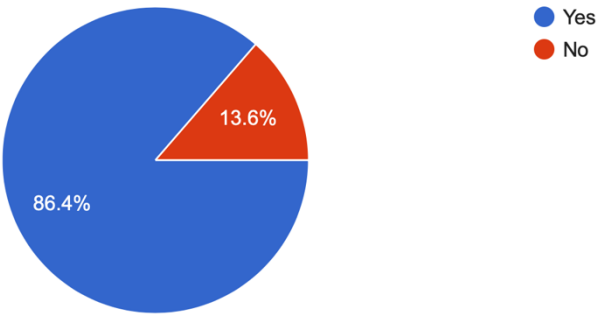

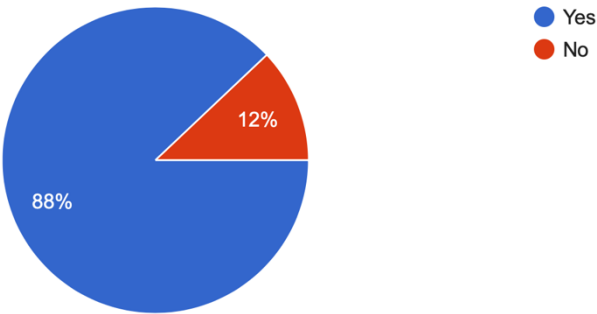

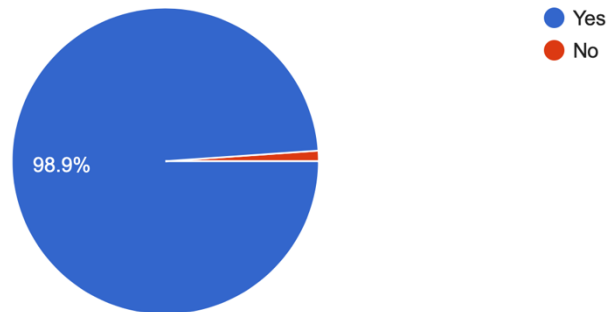


If your child's teacher/s has provided audio lessons were they effective?

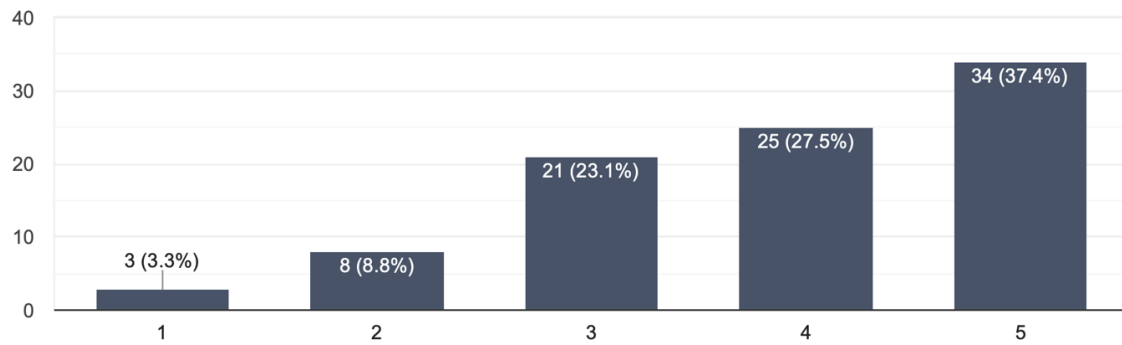

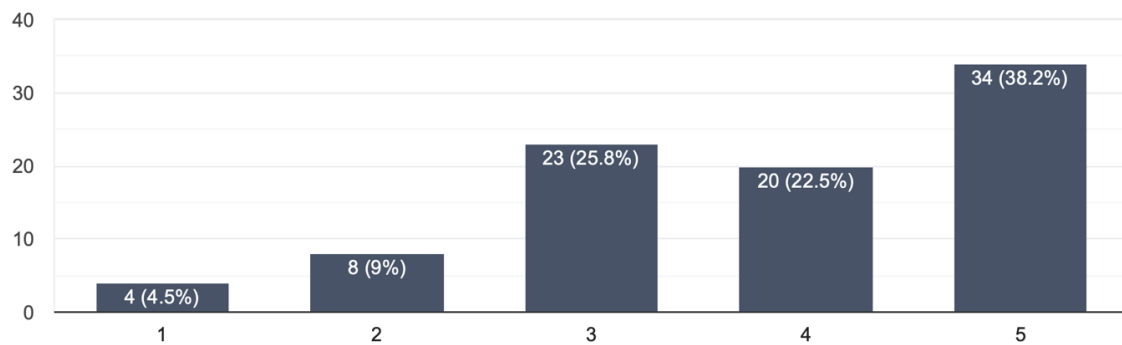
The Zoom calls offer academic support to my child.

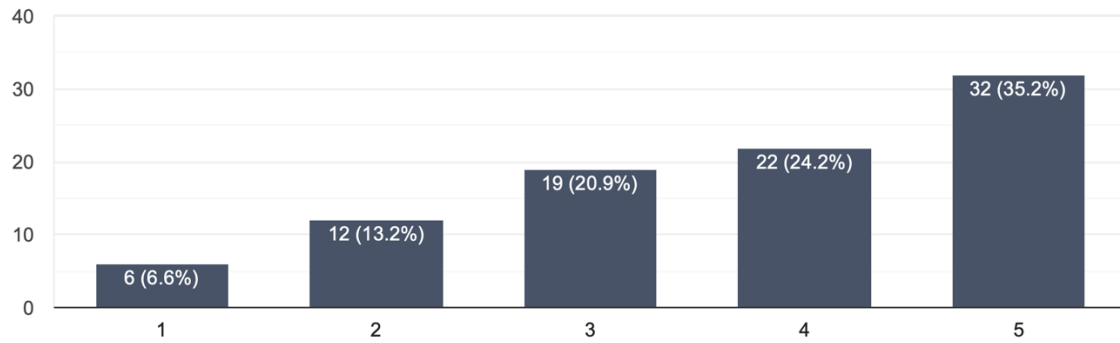
The Zoom calls offer emotional support to my child.

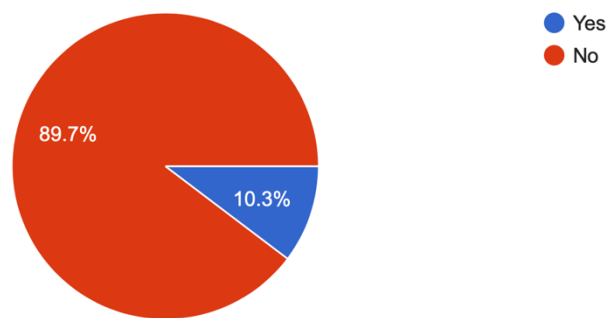

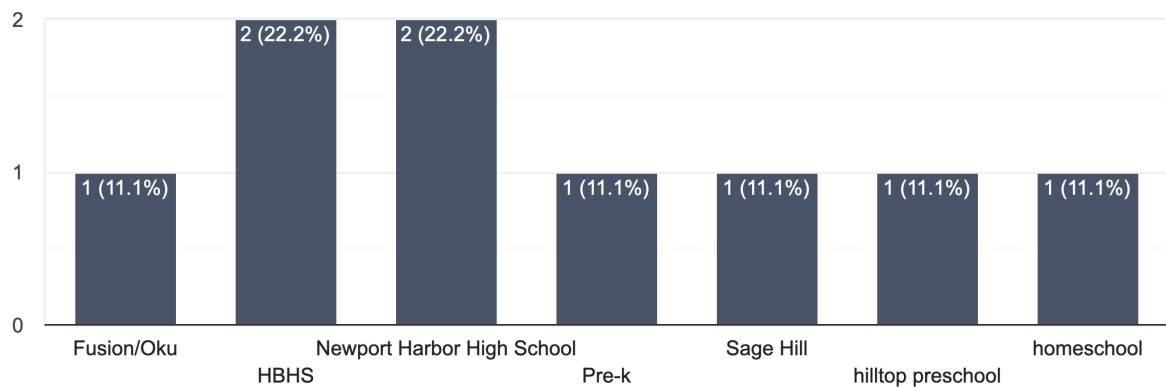
Do you have any children who attend a school other than WSOC?

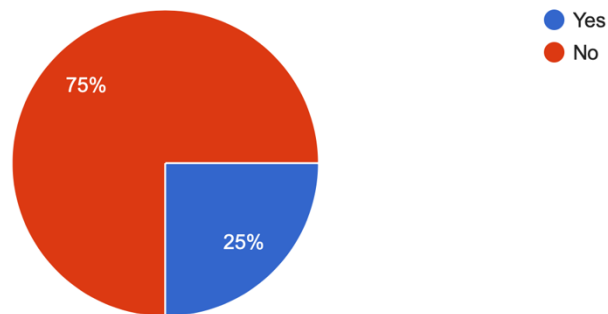

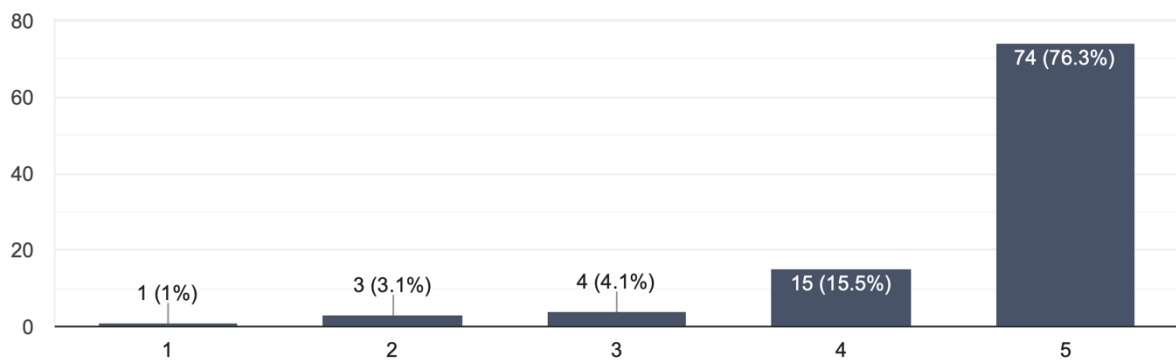

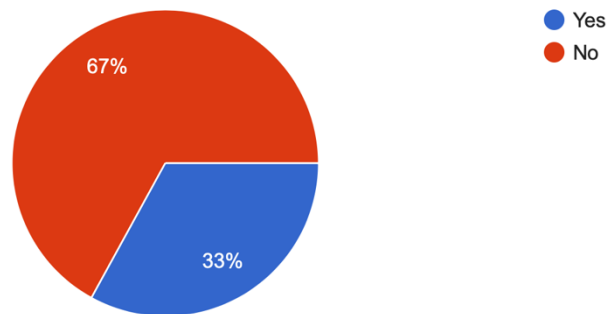

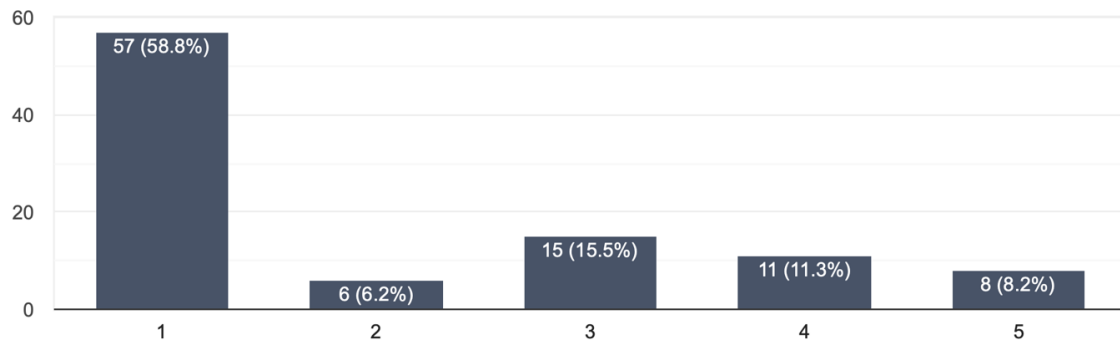

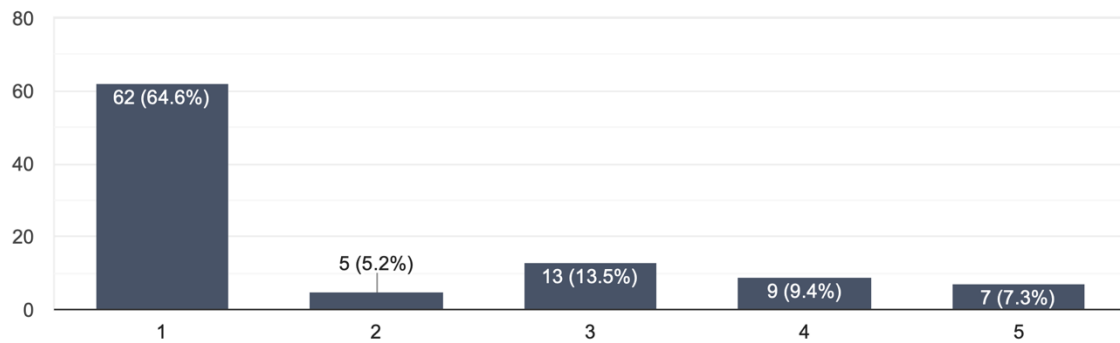
How important is it to you that teachers wear masks to school in the fall ?

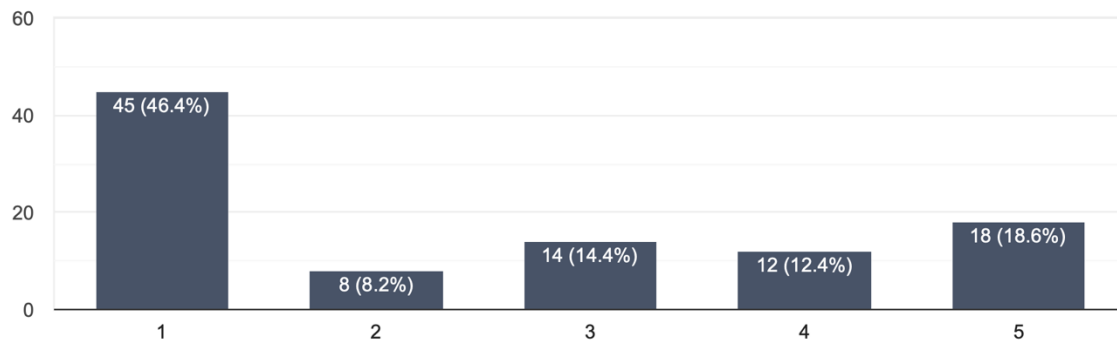
How important is it to you that your child wears a mask to school in the fall?

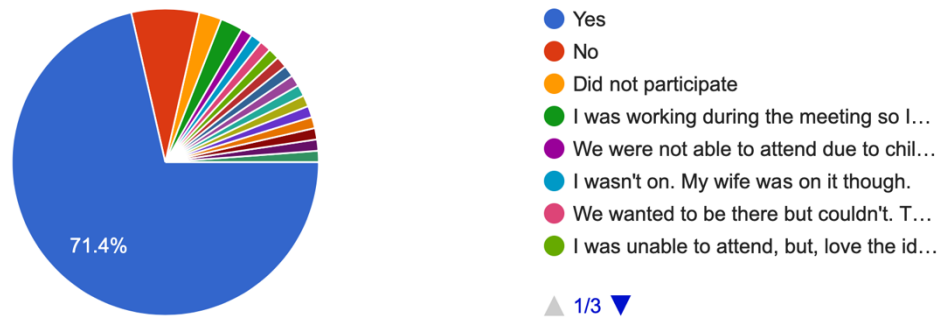

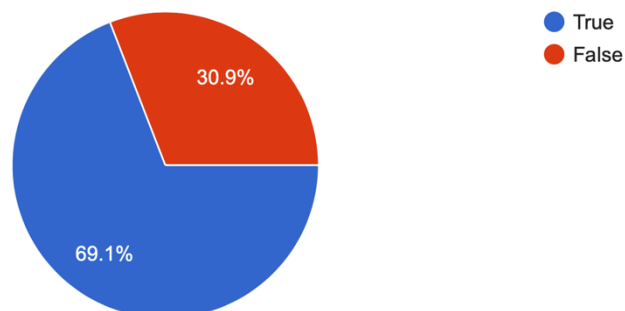
Attending the Town Hall meeting was worth my time?

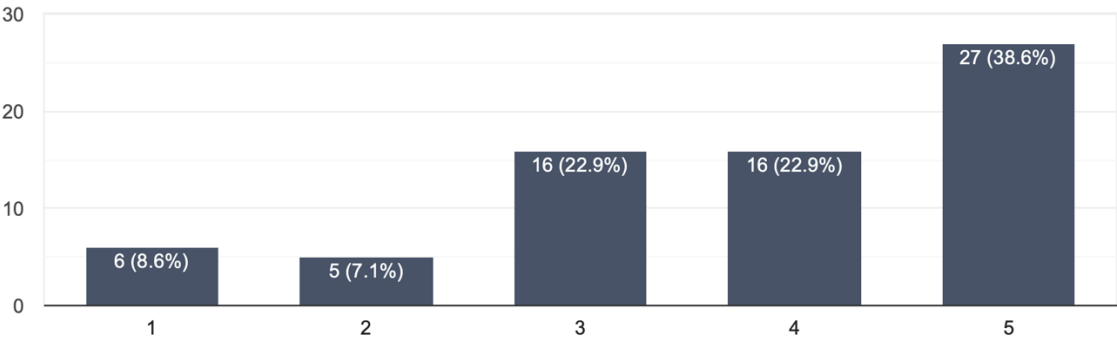
Most of my concerns and questions were addressed at the Town Hall?

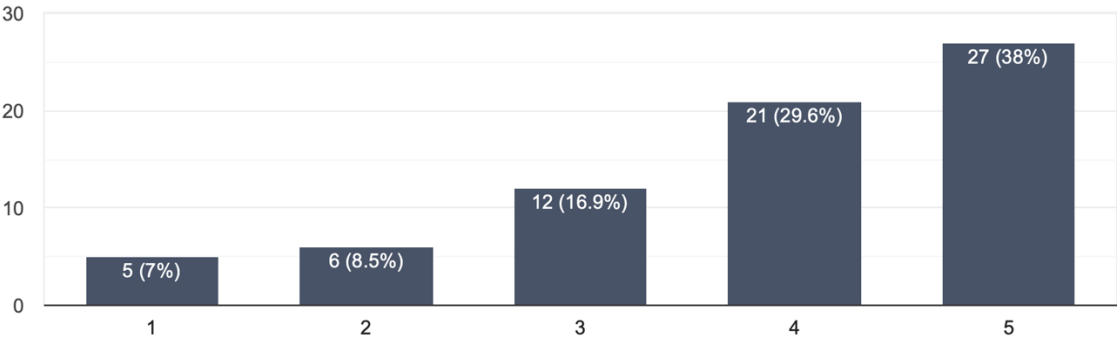
The Town Hall forum fostered my trust in the Back to School Committee?

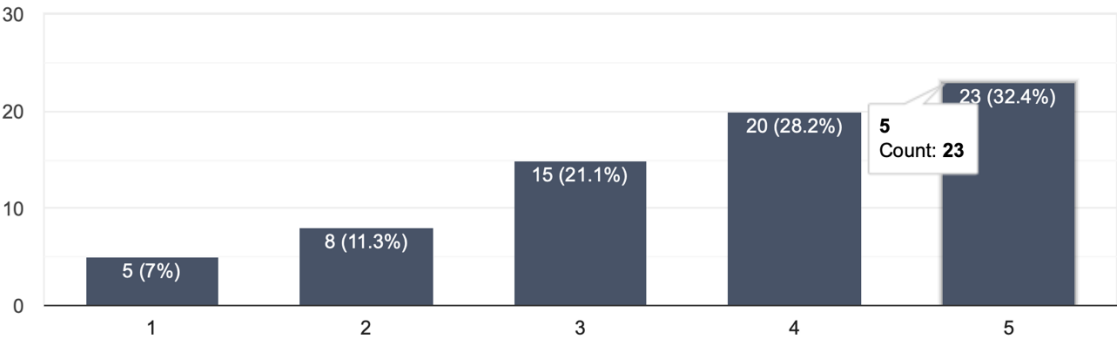
I have a better understanding of WSOC's decision making process during the COVID-19 crisis?

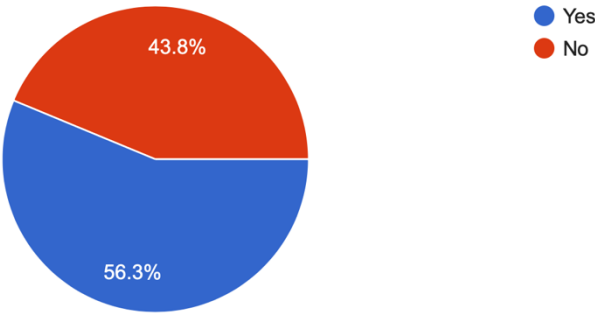
I have a better understanding of finances surrounding WSOC?

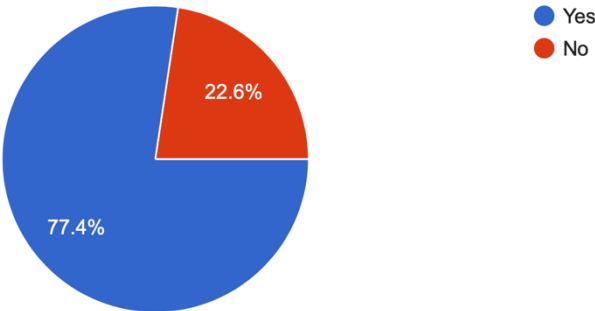

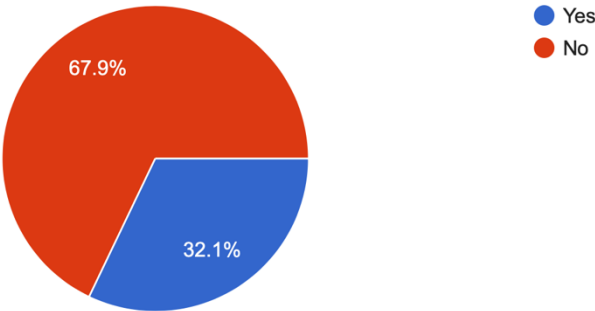
I am comfortable with my child beginning the school year with Scenario A -on campus with smaller cohorts and social distancing?

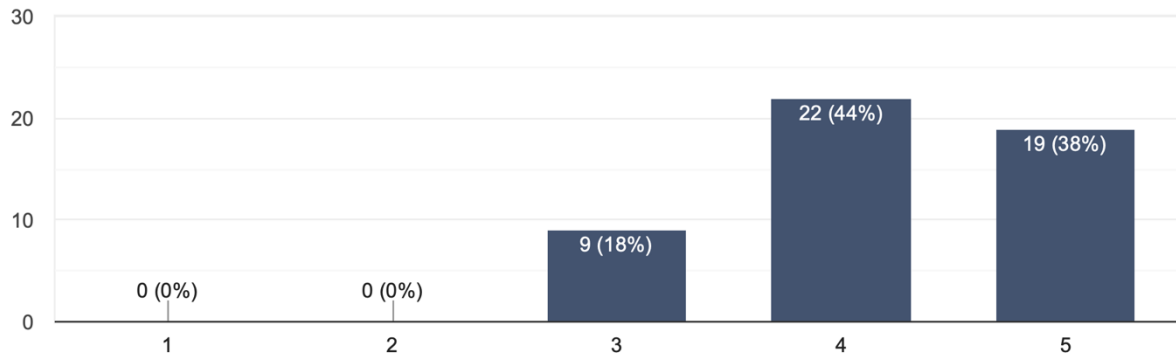

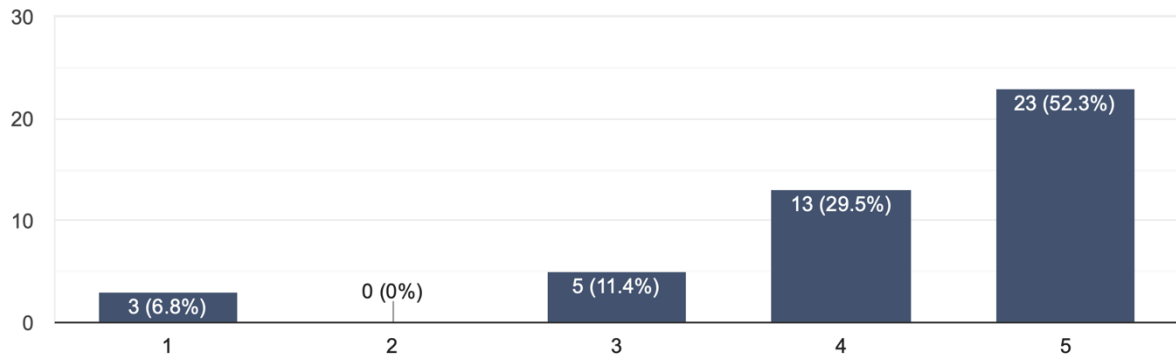
As a whole, how heavy was your child's workload ?

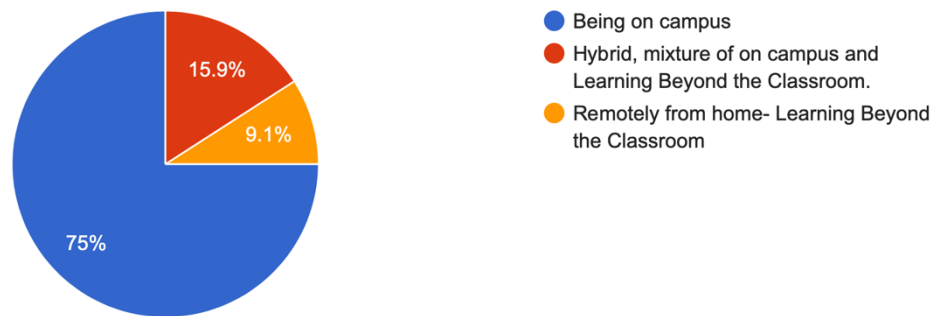
How important is it for your child to begin the 2020-2021 school year on campus?

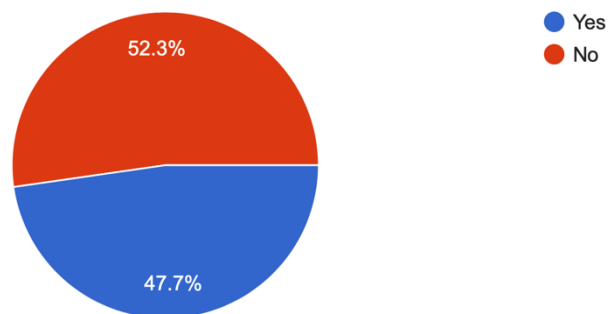
If offered the option please choose which form of learning you prefer for your child in the fall

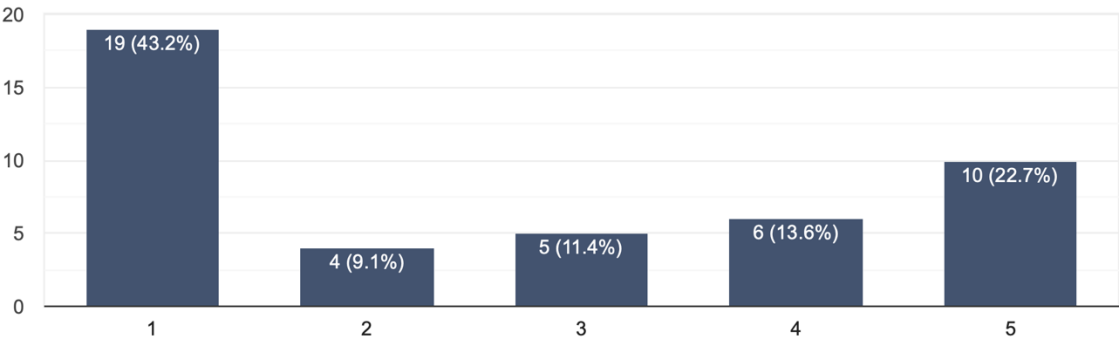
Do you have any health concerns for the return to campus in the fall?

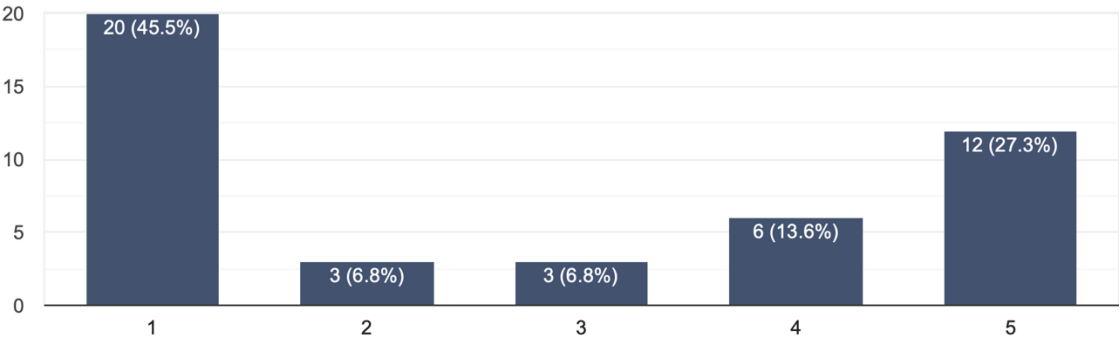
How important is it to you that teachers wear masks to school in the fall ?

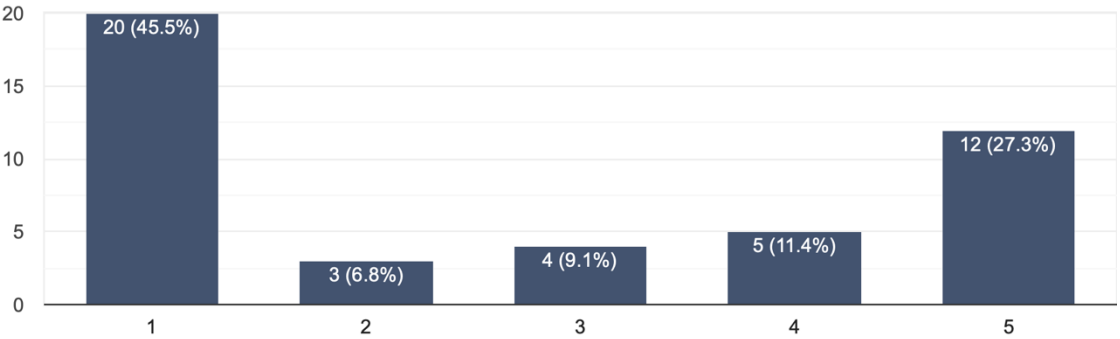
How important is it to you that students wear masks to school in the fall?

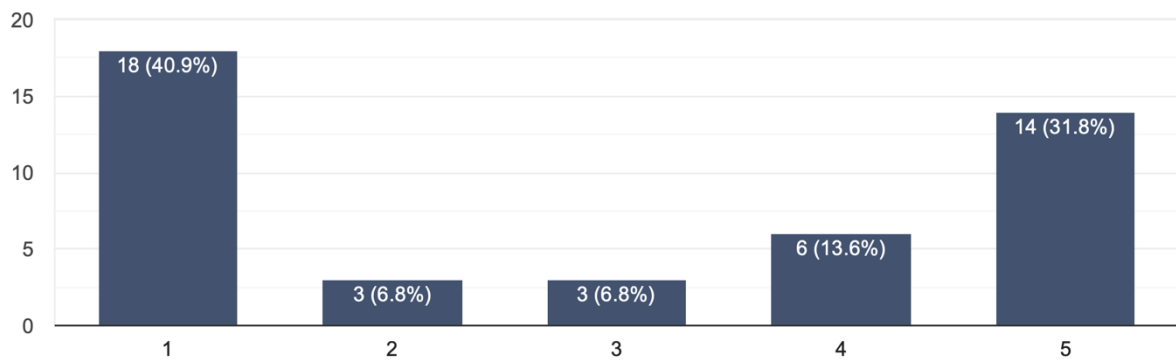

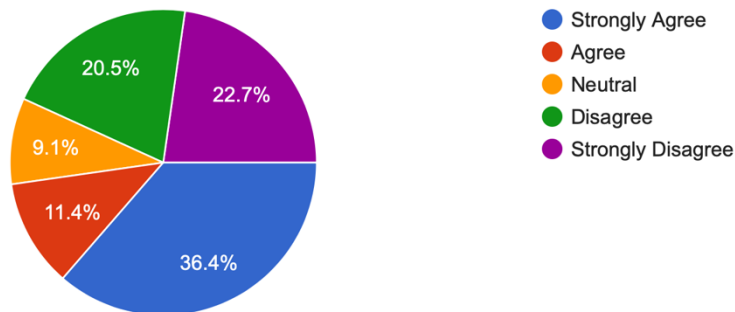
