Child Development and the Basics of Waldorf Education

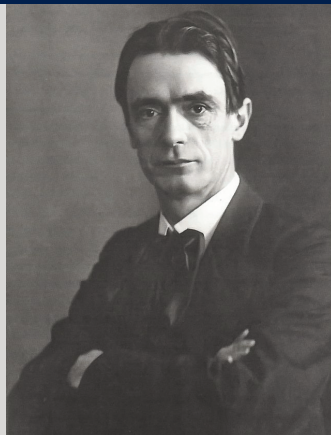
